Q* I am an Active Member of the SAVT and I am not working in the field. May I drop my membership to Non-Practicing?

A. Yes, however, you must meet the requirements of a new member application if you wish to return as an active member in the future. You must have written the VTNE within 3 years and you will be required to submit to a Board of Directors interview to return to active membership. This category is **NOT recommended** to be used when on a maternity leave. If you are grandfathered in as an Active member, you will lose that status. Even if you no longer work in the field at this time (raising a family, moved, etc), there is always the chance that you may return to work as a veterinary technologist. Letting your membership lapse means you have not maintained your continuing education credits which are very important to keep updated on the industry as it is ever changing. If you let your membership lapse over three years you **must rewrite** the Veterinary Technician National Registration Exam (VTNE) administered by the AASVB. If you are not an active member, you are no longer eligible to transfer to another province to work.
